Please review dates and times below before committing to participate, as there will be no alterations made to the schedule unless required by Waverly High School. (There are no refunds for costumes after order has been placed.)

RECITAL DATES: Friday, April 17th, 6:00-8:15 pm Dress rehearsal* (Waverly High School Auditorium)
Saturday, April 18th, Recital 6:00 pm (doors open and students arrive at 5:30 pm) (WHS Auditorium)
*You **MUST** attend dress rehearsal to perform in recital—NO EXCEPTIONS!

It is our goal to run the smoothest, most enjoyable performance possible, and be fair to all of our dancers who have worked so hard through the year. Therefore, recital policies are as follows:

Dress rehearsal: 6:00 pm-all dancers on stage to run Grande Finale, then all dancers can sit in the audience and watch until their number is called. After they have rehearsed, they may leave, or are welcome to stay and watch the rest of the show. **Dress rehearsal is limited to DANCERS & PARENTS ONLY.**

Recital: ALL DANCERS remain backstage for entire performance, and all dancers will participate in Grande Finale at the end of the show. **No students are allowed in auditorium during performance.** Choir room where dancers are waiting will be supervised, and no one will be allowed to roam the school. Parents are welcome to help with costume changes in the dressing room, but due to space constraints, we ask that parents not wait in the choir room. We suggest bringing games, cards, etc. to keep dancers busy. We will have the recital playing in the choir room. The auditorium is not large enough to accommodate our audience and all of our performers. It is customary that the performers remain backstage.

We are very excited about our recital, and want it to be a positive experience for everyone!

2. Costume(s) –costumes are made to fit general sizes, alterations may be necessary, and will be your responsibility.
We order our costumes from many different companies, each using their own size chart, we do our very best to order appropriately!

Costume Details: When your costume(s) come in, check the studio lobby for costume, hair, and make-up details. Instructors will have all necessary information posted. **STUDENTS ARE MEASURED AT THE STUDIO, NO NEED TO SEND MEASUREMENTS.**
